



### Components of a medication orders:

1. Date and time ordered
2. Generic name
3. Dosage (how many mg, gm, ml, units?)
4. Frequency (2 times a day, 3 times a day, at bed time, etc.)
5. Route (oral, NGT, GT, eye instillation, subcutaneous, intramuscular, intravenous, intradermal, inhalation, topical, rectal)
6. Duration (how long to be taken?)
7. Name, ID, and Signature of the physician

### Components of a radiologic investigation order:

1. Date and time ordered
2. Location of irradiation (chest, etc.)
3. View (antero-posterior view, lateral view)
4. Name, ID, and Signature of the physician

### Components of a restraint order (HOH-ND-PPG-09):

1. Start time and stop time (if any)
2. Date and time ordered
3. Reason for restraints (*to be written in the interdisciplinary notes*)
4. Type of restraint used
5. Maximum duration (renewable every 30 days)
6. Name, ID, and Signature of the physician

### REMINDERS:

1. Weekly Progress Notes must be done on weekly basis.
2. Assessment after resident visit must be written on interdisciplinary notes.
3. Re-assessment must be done every 6 months after the last assessment.
4. Intravenous insertion sites other than upper extremity needs to specify in the doctors order. (HOH-ND-PPG-12)
